

SEEPS Camp 2021

February 18-20, 2021 Applications Due: January 9, 2021

Organized by the Society for Environmental Economics and Policy Studies (SEEPS)

In 2021, the Society for Environmental Economics and Policy Studies (SEEPS) will launch a new event called the **SEEPS Camp**. The purpose of this new event is to find and train PhD students and young researchers who will lead the SEEPS in the future. To achieve this purpose, a small group of outstanding PhD students and young researchers will be selected and provided with the opportunity to present their research. The participants will also have the opportunities for intensive discussions. The SEEPS Camp is expected to be a platform for young researchers who engage in environmental economics and policy studies to meet and encourage each other.

Ten participants will present their research plans or outcomes and exchange ideas. They will have an opportunity to join a panel session with mid-career members of the SEEPS who will share how to develop an academic career, and they will also have time to chat with the participants.

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Camp will be held **online** this year. In the future, we plan to organize the Camp in person perhaps for two days.

Eligibility:

To apply for the SEEPS Camp 2021, you must be a PhD student or an early career researcher who has received a PhD within the past five years at the time of the application. Non-members of SEEPS are welcome.
